**206** NP/14/0395 New access and parking for RNLI Lifeboat Station, St Davids, SA62 6PY. The City Council considered that the proposal was deemed unlikely to have a detrimental visual or environmental impact on the surrounding area. It was RESOLVED to support the application.

**207** NP/14/0394 Install an additional H pole structure to the existing 11kv overhead line to accommodate a platform type transformer with underground voltage service connection at New Lifeboat Station, St Davids, SA62 6PY. The City Council considered that the proposal was deemed unlikely to have a detrimental visual or environmental impact on the surrounding area. It was RESOLVED to support the application.

**208** NP/14/0400 Construction of single storey contemporary sun room extension to the rear of property at Clegyr Bach, Clergyr Isaf, SA62 6QN. The City Council considered that the proposal was deemed unlikely to have a detrimental visual or environmental impact on the surrounding area. It was RESOLVED to support the application.

**209** NP/14/0334 Variation of condition 5 of NP/09/088 and condition 2 of NP/12/0283 to allow variation of ridge height at 76.08, 48cm above ridge height at Marychurch (Bluebell Cottage), SA62 6QU. It was RESOLVED to defer this item for further discussion at the next monthly meeting of the City Council on 1st September 2014.

**210** NP/14/0396 Single storey front extension to remodel existing entrance & to enlarge existing living room at Abereiddu, 4 Mount Gardens, SA62 6BS. The City Council considered that the proposal was deemed unlikely to have a detrimental visual or environmental impact on the surrounding area. It was RESOLVED to support the application.

**211** NP/14/0409 Siting of sun loungers, deckchairs, beach wheelchairs & wind break hire concession between 8am and 8pm from 1st March to 31st October at Whitesands Beach. The City Council considered that the proposal was deemed unlikely to have a detrimental visual or environmental impact on the surrounding area. It was RESOLVED to support the application.
